

**Buru Energy** (BRU) is setting casing in the Ungani-4 well at a depth of 2,113 metres before drilling into the Ungani dolomite reservoir. The well is likely to drill out of the casing on Friday once cement has set, and continue drilling for about another 90 metres before logging the reservoir section at this development well.

Log results will be available early next week. StockAnalysis thinks that the well will be completed for testing at a later date, once drilling of the Ungani-5 well has been completed, most likely in mid January '18.

Flow testing at the **Dempsey gas discovery** well in California has commenced with a small and uncommercial clean gas flow from a thin and poorly developed basal sand unit.

Partners at Dempsey don't plan to test the best looking gas units first. The way these wells are tested is from the bottom of the well to the top, irrespective of estimated target quality from drilling and logging data. The Dempsey well penetrated several gas bearing sand units which will be tested in order, from the deepest to the shallowest. In the likely event that a commercial flow is achieved, testing will be halted and the well will be completed for production on the first sand unit that delivers commercial gas flows.
