## Operations Update

Buru Energy is pleased to provide the following update on its Ungani Oilfield operations:

### Ungani access road

The Ungani access road has now been fully reopened and two quads and a triple road train have today left the site with some 2,541 barrels of crude inventory en-route to the storage tank at Wyndham. The remaining crude oil inventory on site is expected to be lifted later this week in accordance with the detailed field re-start and trucking schedule. Re-opening of the road access has involved substantial upgrades to a number of areas that had been damaged by the recent anomalous wet season, and the Company acknowledges the support and assistance provided by local contracting companies and the efforts of Buru's field staff.

### Ungani Oilfield production restart

The field crew has been concentrating on the tie-in of the Ungani 4 flow line and this is substantially complete, and work has now commenced on the Ungani 5 flow line.

Preparations for Ungani 4 testing operations are now underway and the restart of Ungani 1 and Ungani 2 is expected later this week.

A further update will be provided once the Ungani 4 results are to hand and the Ungani 1 and 2 wells have been brought back on line.
